Dear Friends,

We are busily preparing for our furlough. We are flying out on June 24<sup>th</sup>. Please pray for us as we work out the many details involved in leaving for 11 months. Please especially pray for us to find someone to pick people up for church. We actually pick up most of the people each week, so it's very important that we find someone to fill this need.

Please pray for us as we travel to Bangkok next week to renew our visas and missionary work permit. We have to renew these and pay the yearly fee of \$1,810 even though we will be in America almost the whole time. If we don't, then we will lose the missionary work permit that took so many years to get. We also have some doctor appointments scheduled in Bangkok. We are thankful that we can renew the visas the same week as the appointments since in Thailand diesel is now \$4.90 a gallon, and gasoline is \$5.14 a gallon (thankfully our car uses diesel).

Since our departure date is so close, please discontinue sending mail to our Thailand address. You can send mail to us at our home church. The address is at the bottom of this letter. Our voice over internet phone numbers (214-206-1139, 865-745-0480) will remain active until June 22<sup>nd</sup>. We will update you on a new number after we arrive there. The members of our church are sad we are leaving for furlough, but they all seem excited about hearing the Bible college students preach. One little girl even reminded us to make sure that someone keeps picking her up! Please continue to pray for Light Baptist Church! 
In April we asked you to pray for a German man with cancer. He died several weeks ago. As far as we know, he wasn't saved. He never allowed us to visit with him, but we do know that a German friend of his was able to witness to him. Please pray for his wife and daughter.

God has been answering prayers for Richard's health. He hasn't had a seizure in 3 ½ months, he's preaching every week, and this week he is teaching a week long Bible college class. After working for weeks on notes and outlines for the classes, his computer broke and lost all of his work. God not only helped him to think of an inexpensive way to repair the computer, but He helped him to redo all the work in only 2 weeks! God has strengthened him for all that he has had to do each day! He is still working at scheduling furlough meetings. We have most of our supporting churches scheduled and around 20 new churches. Each of you that pray for us and support us are truly co-workers in spreading the Gospel to the Thai people. We appreciate each of and the sacrifices you make to help us serve the Lord here in Tak.
