Dear Friends,

Thailand, usually called the land of smiles, hasn't had much to smile about lately. This is the seventh week of a huge protest in Bangkok. Although it began as a "peaceful" protest, twenty-seven people have died and over 800 people have been wounded. We are a six hour drive from Bangkok where the protest is, so we are safe. Please pray for peace in Thailand and for the protest not to spread into other cities.

God is really blessing our deaf ministry! After only having one deaf member for the past 3 years, we have finally begun to see growth. We had a deaf man get saved a couple of months ago, and then a deaf lady got saved 2 weeks later. Then shortly after that, we had 5 other deaf people visit the church. Please pray for those visitors to come back to church! God has given us such a burden to reach the deaf, but it has seemed at times to be an unreachable goal. But with God all things are possible, and we are so thankful for God giving us fruit at last!

We also had 3 children get saved in March. One was a boy who used to lie, steal from his parents, and lay out of school. His mother told us that his behavior has completely changed since he started coming to church. She said that she is so thankful for us helping him. Those changes were before he got saved, but now that he is saved, we are seeing more changes in him. What a blessing to watch God molding this 12 year old!

We had a baptism service in March. Four Thai people and two of our sons were baptized. The river was really crowded, so it was a wonderful opportunity to be a testimony to the whole community.

God has also opened the doors for Richard and Matthew to teach in the Tak prison again. They are so excited to be sharing the Gospel there again! Please pray for the prisoners to get saved.

Please continue to pray about Kristi's health. The Vitamin B12 helped some, but only to a point. She has been getting worse again. The doctor says that he doesn't know what it is and suggests that she get another opinion. His only other suggestion was to stay cool. He felt that the heat might be making the symptoms worse. We have had highs of 110° or more and lows of around 90° almost every day for the last 2 months. Since we don't have air conditioning in our house, he felt like the heat may be why she is getting worse. We have a little savings set aside for a much needed van, but now we are considering using it for air conditioning. Please pray for God to lead us in this decision. Please also pray for us to know which doctor to see next.
