In our March letter, we asked you to pray for a new family who started coming to church. The man said he was anti-Christian. It has been our great pleasure to watch God reveal Himself to him. He quickly began to understand the Gospel, and he was saved in April. One of his teenage daughters was saved shortly after her father. Please continue to pray for his wife and other daughter to be saved.

A Thai teenage boy and our son, Micah, were also saved in April. We had a baptism at the river in May. Our children, Micah and Sarah, and the father and daughter that were recently saved were all baptized!

We had a special program for Easter at both our church and at the prison. At the church we had about 50 people attend. It was a great opportunity to present the Gospel. At the prison, it was encouraging to watch the saved prisoners' excitement as they were able to act out a play to share the Gospel with their fellow inmates. Pray for them as they witness to the other prisoners.

Our second oldest child, Marah, just went to America last week. She will spend the summer with our families in Tennessee, and then begin school at Oklahoma Baptist College in August. Please pray for Marah as she readjusts to living in America after living in Thailand for 10 ½ years. Please pray for all of us during this time of transition.
