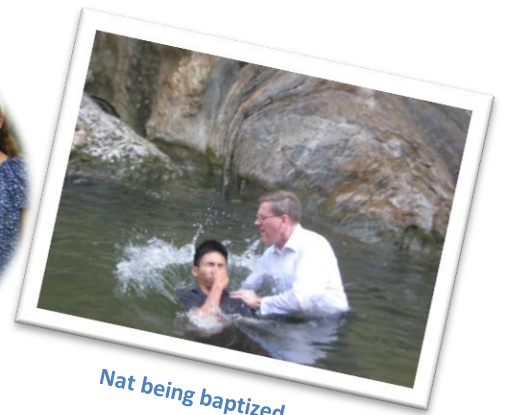

Dear Friends,

We had a really special time celebrating Easter this year. Brother Philip Pope came and preached during our morning service. That was a special blessing! Several of our English students came to church for Easter! Then we had a baptism at a nearby waterfall that afternoon. The waterfall was really crowded, and though many people left when we began the baptism service, many others stayed and watched. It was special to watch Nat and Lin's willingness to follow the Lord in baptism even with so many onlookers.

The Easter service at the prison was amazing. At the end of the service many prisoners and even a guard seemed very touched. Although no one was saved, many seem to be beginning to understand the Gospel. Please remember to pray for them to be saved! Due to some guard changes, we haven't been permitted to teach at the prison for the past 3 weeks. Please pray for us to be able to resume our classes there again quickly.

A new school year has just begun here. Please pray for Richard, Joshua, and Elisabeth as they continue teaching English and Bible classes in 2 public schools. At the end of last school year around 15 students had started coming to church on Sundays, but during the summer break all but one quit coming. Please pray for the kids to start coming back to church.



Last month our car broke down on the highway as we were on our way to Bangkok for a doctor's appointment. We had to wait on the side of the road for a couple of hours as we waited on a tow truck. That would have been bad on any day, but it was really miserable because it was 110 degrees! The problem was expensive and frustrating, but we have much to be thankful for. God kept us safe on the side of the road, some people with a roadside stand offered us a place to sit in the shade, and we all made it home safely! We had



to have the engine completely rebuilt. We are thankful that it is once again running okay.


