We are so thankful for the work God is doing in us and through us. As 2013 came to an end, it marked the end of the saddest and most difficult year of our lives, our first year without Josiah and Sarah. However it also marked one



of the best years in our ministry here. In spite of the sorrow we have been going through, God has enabled us to keep sowing and watering seeds, and He has given the increase of over 20 souls saved! We have heard it said that God doesn't call the equipped, but that He equips the called. And this year that has been so proven here. When we barely felt capable of anything, God has poured out His blessings. We praise the Lord for the work that He is doing here!

For several years we have been picking up a family 45 minutes away for church. It has been a real struggle to pick them up in addition to all of the people that that



we pick up. We have been praying for a way to start a church in their area for a long time. Now we have finally begun to work on that project. We are renting a community center on Saturday afternoons and having

a free English class with a Bible lesson afterwards, and then after that we are having a church service. We have been doing this for a month now. The English classes have had lots of kids, and last week we had 7 in attendance for the church service. That was mostly children, but we are excited to see what God will do with this new outreach!

Each December always gives us a great opportunity to share the Gospel through Christmas programs. This year we held Christmas programs in 3 public schools, our church, and at our new outreach. Altogether we presented the True Meaning of Christmas to around 1,340 people!

Our new auditorium was completed before Christmas! We are so thankful to have somewhere big enough for everyone. It can seat 120! Thanks for all the prayers for its completion.

We have recently had many Karen (a hill tribe) Children from Burma coming to church. Most of them speak Thai fluently, but we are having trouble communicating with 2 of them and with all of their parents. Please pray for us as we try to have wisdom in how to teach them about Christ.
