God blessed us with a wonderful Easter service at the church and then a baptism at a nearby waterfall afterwards. It was a blessing to see 8 new believers baptized. We have 4 more people ready for our next baptism already! Praise the Lord for the new converts!

One young man who was saved in December had a difficult time of testing recently. He was scared to tell his mother that he was coming to church, so he just let her think he was coming here for English classes. God began to convict him about this. At the same time she realized he was lying to her and insisted that he become a Buddhist monk. He asked our advice, and we told him to tell the truth and trust God to help him. His mother called Kristi and said she was about to kick her son out. Kristi prayed for wisdom, and God gave her the right words to say to calm his mother down and help her understand. She even got to witness to his mother. The next day the mother told her son that he didn't have to become a monk, and that it was okay with her if he was a Christian! Praise the Lord for this victory! Please pray for Thai Christians who lack courage to tell their family members about their new faith, and also pray for those who haven't gotten saved simply because they are scared of how their families will react.

It is a joy to see the church growing, yet we have some of the same discouraging problems that most churches have. Our church needs prayer for spiritual growth, for people to be more faithful, and for people to get more involved in serving God. Please help us to pray for God to raise up and equip more Thai people to serve here and to strengthen those who are already serving in our church!

Please also continue to pray for our newest outreach in Ban Mai (45 minutes away). We are still having English classes and a church service there every Saturday. Our attendance has been low, but we are thankful for the opportunity to teach the people there about God. Please pray that more people will attend the services and that people will be saved.
