Some parents just find other things for the kids to do at the same time as church. Others are fine with the kids coming to church, but won't allow them to be baptized. Please pray for the children to know how to be respectful to their parents in these difficult situations. Pray for the parents to be saved!

Our church had a baptism service on Oct. 5th. We usually have our baptisms at a local waterfall. Although it is a beautiful location, it is inconvenient to take large groups there. We prayed for God to show us a better place. Then, the Special Education Center here allowed us to use their swimming pool! It was perfect! We are thankful for the 5 new Christians who were baptized and for God's provision of a convenient location. We are also excited that 3 more people have been saved since then!

Last week we had our first children's camp. Twenty-eight kids joined in for 2 days of fun activities and Bible lessons.
