# The Guay Family - Your missionaries in Thailand

Dear Friends,

God has been doing amazing things here. He has been reminding us of the truth of Ephesians 3:20, which says, "Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us"

Often the older people are, the harder it is to reach them. We had been praying for an 85 year old lady, whose son is a member of our church. She was sick and expected to die. One of the men in the church went to visit her last month, and she got saved! She passed away less than two weeks later. Then another church member asked Richard to visit a friend of his. He is 82 and bedridden. Richard shared the Gospel with him and he was saved! We are so thankful how God worked in the lives of these older people.

Then God opened up an opportunity for Richard to preach the Gospel at a Buddhist Temple. Almost all of the family of the lady who died were Buddhist, so even though she was a new Christian, they had her funeral at the Buddhist temple. Her son that is a Christian was able to get permission from the head monk to have a Christian service for her before the cremation. So, Richard preached about the one true God. Some of the lost family members came to the service, and it was playing over the loud speakers for all to hear!

For several months we have been witnessing to an alcoholic man. He started drinking when he was in 3rd grade. He is now forty and has liver disease as a result of drinking. He has been coming to church for a while, and last Sunday he came asking how to be saved. Richard was able to share the Gospel with him, and he was saved! He came over for a Bible study today, and he was so excited about his new faith! Please pray that it will be easy for him to quit drinking.

Before our son, Josiah, died, he witnessed to one of his friends, who later got saved. At the time the boy was 13. When his family learned that he was a Christian, they forbid him to come to church. We encouraged him to keep reading the Bible and praying. He had to sneak to read his Bible. We have prayed for him and visited him some, but his family always said no when he asked to come to church. Now he is almost 17, and his family makes him work in a bar with his brother. He finally got permission to come to church last week. We were so amazed to talk to him and discover that in spite of not being allowed to come to church for 3 year and working in a bar, this boy has really grown closer to God. He is still reading his Bible and praying. He still trusts the Lord. We are so thankful for how God protected him during this time.

Also in our last prayer letter, we asked you to pray for two children whose mother wouldn't let them come back to church. She changed her mind right after we sent that letter. We are thankful to have them back in church!

Thank you for all of your prayers. God is definitely doing far above what we have asked! We will be celebrating the 10th anniversary of Light Baptist church this month, and we look forward to seeing what God has in store for this church in the years to come!
