After that we want to focus on handing them out to soldiers at the army base.

With school starting back, we are eager to get back into our school ministries. We will be teaching English and Bible lessons in three schools this year. We have added more classes in two of the schools. We will also continue having a church service at one school on Sunday afternoons. Please pray for the students and teachers to be saved.

Please continue to pray for Kristi's mother as she is suffering with COPD. Kristi was able to go help care for her in April. While she was there, Kristi had some testing done to try to determine the cause of her frequent stomachaches. She had an endoscopy and an ultrasound done. The endoscopy caused her to get pneumonia. So, she ended up being very sick during part of the trip. However, the ultrasound revealed the problem. It showed that she had many gallstones. So, last week when she returned to Thailand, she had surgery in Bangkok to remove her gallbladder. She is still recovering, but we are hopeful that this will solve the problem at last!

While Kristi was away, Micah came down with Chicken Pox, and then as soon as he recovered, Richard got pneumonia, a sinus infection, and an ear infection all at once. He still has bronchitis and a sinus infection after several weeks. Please pray for him.
