In November, we handed out thousands of tracts at the Loy Kratong Festival. Many of our church members helped us, and it was a blessing watching them witness to others. We were able to witness to many people, both hearing and deaf. One teenage girl started coming to church after receiving a tract there. She has been coming faithfully since then and has recently gotten saved!

During December, we had Christmas programs in two schools, the prison, and at our church. The hard work of preparing done by our family and church members was well worth it for the opportunity to present the Gospel to around 800 students and teachers, 30 prisoners and guards, and 100 members of our community. The prison broadcasted the program over the speakers for the whole prison to hear as well. It is a blessing that Christmas opens so many doors for telling others about God!

Thank you for praying for Kristi. Her health has improved quite a bit after trying a gluten free diet. Now, her doctor is having her eat gluten again so that she can be tested for Celiac Disease. The doctor says that she most likely has it. She will have an endoscopy done at the end of February. She is already feeling very bad from eating the gluten. Please pray for her.
