We are excited to share with you that we bought the property we mentioned in our September letter. At the moment a fence around the property is being built. We are using money from inheritance that we received. We hope to begin building the church in just a couple of weeks. There is enough of the money that we are donating from the inheritance to build the church with an auditorium, a small office, a small sound room, a classroom, and restrooms. We had hoped to build a fellowship hall that would also be used as a children's church and a couple more classes, but we don't have enough funds for that. It will be okay if we can't do that at this time, but we wanted to share this need with you. Some people have asked about helping with the building or about helping with big projects, so we wanted to share this need for those who might be interested in helping. In order to make the building big enough for the fellowship hall/children's church we would need between \$20,000 to \$25,000 more. If anyone would like to help out with this, you can send a check to Galilean Baptist Church. Please include a note letting us know it is for the new church building. We have been so encouraged by how our church is growing. Not only is it a blessing to watch the church grow in number, but it is a bigger blessing to see the members growing spiritually and helping each other. A teenager came last night who is struggling with some big problems. It was wonderful to watch all the adults as they prayed for her and encouraged her. One lady who is struggling with cancer herself shared how God is helping her through her

trial. Another lady who is blind and lives alone shared with her how God helps her daily. It is a blessing to be a part of what God is doing here in Tak, Thailand.

We had Christmas services in three schools. It was once again a great opportunity to share the true meaning of Christmas with the students and teachers. At church we had Christmas services in three different languages. Around 80 people came to the Burmese Christmas service, also around 80 people came for the Thai Christmas service, and 17 people came for the Christmas service for English speakers. There

were people from Thailand, Myanmar, America, the Philippines, Wales, and Ireland! It is exciting to share the gospel with people from all over the world!

Please also pray for our health. All of us have been sick with sinus infections and bronchitis and Richard fell and fractured his foot two weeks ago. He got the cast off yesterday, but it is still swollen and painful.

Thank you for your prayers for us and our ministry. God is blessing and we are so thankful to Him and to each of you who make it possible for us to serve here. God bless you!
