We are sorry for the lateness of this letter. This has been a really busy time for us, and time passed quickly. We hope you are doing well.

Our building project has been taking up much more of our time than we thought it would even though a construction crew is doing the actual building. We have been busy with planning, picking out things, and inspecting the progress. We are pleased with the progress. The church is turning out beautiful! Our house should be done in the next couple of weeks and the church will be done in another month or two. Please pray that the move will be uneventful and that the change of location won't discourage people from coming. In order to get a good price on the land, we bought land that is slightly out of town and 400 meters of the road is dirt. The church members don't think this should be a problem. We have prayed much about this decision and feel it is God's will. Also, please pray that we can get permission to put a cemetery at the back of the property. We are thankful for your prayers about this, the special offering for the church, and the continual faithful support.

We were able to begin having services in our church again in June. We were all very grateful to worship the Lord together again! This pandemic made us more thankful than ever for the freedom to join together at church. Since then, two teens and one adult have been saved! We have had several visitors too. We have three teens ready to be baptized, but their parents have asked them to wait until they are 20. It is a blessing that these teens were brave enough to tell their parents about their faith in Jesus. This is such a difficult step for them to take. One of the mothers came to some of the the baptism classes with her daughter, and now she is coming to church with her daughter. We have known this family for years. It is so encouraging to see God working in them!

Schools have been opened back up in Thailand for over a month. We are back to teaching English and Bible in three schools. We are thankful for the opportunity! Please pray for students and teachers to trust in Jesus.

After 26 years of homeschooling, our last homeschooler graduated, and after over 31 years of having children in the house, we have become empty nesters. Micah left home last week to study at Bob Jones University. We had hoped to take him and help him get settled, but that wasn't possible due to Coronavirus. Thailand has opened back up in most ways, but the country is closed to most foreigners. If we leave Thailand, we wouldn't be allowed back in. Goodbyes are always hard, but this one was extra hard, because we have no idea when we can see him again. He can't get back into Thailand and we can't leave. Please pray for Micah and for Elijah (who is a senior at Pensacola Christian College) during this unpredictable school year. Please pray for us parents as we adjust to this new stage of life.
