We are currently in America taking a one month furlough. Since we always find it hard to be away from the ministry in Thailand for long furloughs, we really hope to begin taking one month furloughs every year or every other year. This will enable us to update supporting churches and visit family, but not take too much time away from our work in Thailand. This time we are visiting churches in Tennessee, North Carolina, and South Carolina. We were blessed to spend Easter with three of our sons, one daughter-in-law, and lots of extended family! We are thankful for our son-in-law and daughter, several preachers, and church members filling in for us so that we could be away.

The fear of Covid is finally letting up in Thailand! As people are beginning to go back to normal life, we have had an increase of people coming to the church for English classes and for church services! Several church members are faithfully joining us to hand out tracts each week! We are definitely seeing results from that.

In March a young man received a tract and John/Romans at his house. He read all of it and came to church for a Wednesday night service. Richard answered a lot of Bible questions for him and gave him a full Bible. He came back the next night to help hand out tracts. As we handed out tracts, Richard and Naut, our son-in-law, answered many more of his questions. He came back on Sunday saying he had read Genesis, Exodus, and Leviticus already. He was so eager to know Jesus! He got saved that night! Please pray for his spiritual growth and for many more to receive the Gospel with such enthusiasm.

Richard was finally able to go back to teaching English and Bible at the boarding school, and we were able to begin having Sunday services at that school again. The students have been so eager to come. We have fifty or more every Sunday! Two of the boys are playing the guitar and a group of the teens have been singing for us each week! Please pray for the lost kids to get saved and the Christian kids to grow in the Lord. Another school asked Kristi to begin teaching English and Bible at their school, so she is now teaching in four schools each week. So over 200 students are learning about Jesus in public schools each week! Praise the Lord for this open door.

Some of the school kids come to church too. One of the girls got saved at church in February! Many of the kids came to a youth group party at our house in March. One of the teens really wants to be saved, but he is hesitant because his mom is Muslim and his dad is Buddhist. Please pray for him and many of the other kids who want to be Christians, but their parents don't approve. Pray for us to be able to reach the parents as well!

We are so thankful for each of you who help in this ministry to the people of Thailand. Whether you help by praying, giving, or both, God is using you to help people know Him and His great love. Thank you!
