Kristi went over to encourage her to join us. Since she was reluctant to join the others, Kristi asked if she could do a Bible study with her and she was able to use that time to witness to her. One of the girl's friends told us how this girl had been really sick a couple of months before and that she encouraged her to read the John/Romans that we had given the students. When she came back hours later, the sick girl had fallen asleep hugging the John/Romans. She listened eagerly as Kristi witnessed to her. Though she hasn't gotten saved yet, God is definitely working on her heart. Please pray for her to understand the Gospel and put her trust in Jesus.

A couple of weeks ago while doing visitation, we ran into four former students. As we began to invite them to church, they all excitedly told us that they still had the Genesis/John/Romans that we had given them several years ago. Though none of these kids had seemed very interested in knowing Jesus when we taught them, they had all kept the portions of the Bible we gave to them, and they were all quick to get directions to the church and say they might come. Many of them take turns making Sunday lunch for the whole church, take turns teaching children's church, and help us hand out tracts.
