We are excited to share some of the things God has been doing recently. He used a couple of young men to remind us not to give up when people quit coming to church. One boy came to our church as a child, and he got saved when he was about eight. He was so excited about God and would get out of the van singing songs he learned at church when we took him home. But then his parents quit allowing his sister and him to come. We visited off and on, but honestly, we didn't think those kids would ever return. Then a couple of months ago both the boy and his sister came back. Now he is 16, and he loves the Lord and still wants to follow Him! His sister isn't saved yet, but she is very interested! Another young man got saved through our school ministry when he was twelve. Now he is 26. He has been in and out of church all of these years. But now has really started being faithful to church. He shared with us last week that he has read his Bible all the way through 10 times! And he let us know how much God is using us in the schools. It was really nice to hear that from a former student.

We had a youth camp at our church at the beginning of April. We had 19 teens and pre-teens attend. God has really blessed us with great group of kids who desire to follow Him.



God also keeps showing us how He can work all things together for good. A while back as one dad waited for his kids in English class, he asked Richard many questions about Jesus. Losing a brother in a car accident had caused him to turn from all religion. But seeing us love and serve the Lord even though we have lost two children in a car accident made him curious about Jesus. Richard witnessed to him. Recently, he got saved, and then his wife and two of their little girls got saved. They all got baptized on Easter Sunday!

Also, our church attendance has been up every Sunday. We had 58 people come for Easter and five got baptized!
