Thank you for all your prayers for Kristi. She was diagnosed with a rare strain of NTM Lung Disease. Last week the doctors decided to start her on treatment of two strong antibiotics. The plan was to take them for at least a year. In spite of the risk of side effects, the doctors believe this is necessary because the NTM is already causing damage to the lungs. In fact, there is a small area that has collapsed already. She began two medications while in the hospital last week, and she almost immediately had a bad reaction to one of them. The doctor changed her to a different medication. She came home, and two days ago she began to have stabbing pains in the eyes. The doctor said it was a side effect and said to discontinue the medication. She will have to go back to Bangkok in a few days to see the doctor. He is trying to decide which medication to try next. There are only a small number of antibiotics that can stop this bacteria, and they all have some dangerous side effects. Please pray for the doctors to have wisdom, and please pray



for healing. This has definitely taken us by surprise, but we know God wasn't surprised. The Bible says, "Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night...Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness." Psalm 91:5-6 One doctor said she may have had this for up to five years. As this bacteria was slowly growing in darkness, God knew. And we know we can trust Him with this.



In spite of illness, God has been blessing! We had a wonderful time sharing about Jesus' birthday in five schools in December. We also had over a 100 people come to a Christmas program at the church. Also, we did lots of Christmas activities in our

December English classes. Christmas opens so many doors to share the Gospel.



We set up a booth with activities at a market for Children's Day. We had games, prizes, and face painting. But the best part of the evening was sharing the Gospel with the kids as they got their faces painted. Several church members joined in and helped witness to the kids! Also, each child received a bag with a John/Romans, a Christian

book, a tract, and an invitation to church. It was a great opportunity to sow seeds!



In our last letter we mentioned renting a small place to start a new church. We painted it and are all ready to begin, but the frequent doctor's appointments, sickness, and the busy schedule for Christmas programs in Tak have kept us from being able to begin having classes and services there. Please pray for us to know God's will about a date to begin. We are eager to get started!



Also, God blessed us with a new granddaughter on November 7th. Victoria Ariya Wanchai is our fifth grandchild! Praise the Lord for his blessings!
