The Lord has been so good to our family and our ministry! This prayer letter is a little later than usual because we wanted to wait until after the 20th anniversary celebration of Light Baptist Church so we could share it with you. Looking back over these twenty years reminds us once again of God's faithfulness. We are so thankful for His many blessings and for your faithful prayers and support that have made it possible for us to continue serving Him here in Thailand.

The anniversary service was a wonderful day! We were honored to have our pastor, Bro. Matthew Wilkerson, from Texas, and missionary, Bro. Ricky Salmon, from Bangkok, preach during the special service. The Lord blessed us with over 90 people in attendance as we celebrated all that He has done over the past twenty years.



One of the greatest blessings of the anniversary was having three of our children, two son-in-laws, one daughter-in-law, and five grandchildren with us for the celebration. Looking back over these twenty years reminded us how much our family has sacrificed for the ministry. During the early years, all eight of our children faithfully served alongside us in countless ways. We thank the Lord for each of them and are grateful that so many could be with us to celebrate all that God has done.



Our pastor's daughter, Hope Wilkerson, also came to visit with her dad. She was a tremendous blessing as she helped teach in our English classes during her stay.

As part of the anniversary celebration, we recognized many of our faithful church members who serve in different ministries throughout the church. We were thankful for the opportunity to present each of them with a small

gift of appreciation. Looking back over twenty years reminds us that the Lord has built His church through the faithful service of many people, and we thank God for each one.

Two weeks ago, we experienced a very sad loss. One of Kristi's students, who attended both her English classes at school and at church, was killed in a motorcycle accident along with his mother, who taught at one of the schools where Kristi teaches.

They had visited our church several times, but neither had trusted Christ as Savior. Our hearts have been heavy as we grieve with their family and friends. Please pray that God will comfort those who are hurting. Please also pray that the Lord will give us wisdom as we seek to reach students and their families with the Gospel while there is still time.



We are also encouraged by what God is doing in our new church, Abundant Love Baptist Church, in Sukhothai. The church is beginning to grow. We now have two Christian men who are faithfully attending the services. We also have a father and his daughter who have been coming to some of the services and asking many questions about Christianity. It is encouraging to see their interest in God's Word as they continue searching for answers. Please pray that the Lord will open their hearts and that they will trust Christ as their Savior.



We are also thankful for a group of young men from Light Baptist Church who faithfully help us pass out Gospel tracts near the new church each week. It is exciting to see them willing to invest their time in helping reach others with the Gospel.

Please continue to pray for our health. Richard has been struggling much more with the dizziness caused by Ménière's disease. At times it has been very disabling and

has caused him to fall several times. We are thankful that some new medication has helped, but we would appreciate your prayers for the Lord's healing. Please continue to pray for healing for Kristi as well.

Thank you for faithfully praying for our family and our ministry. We know that none of this would be possible without faithful friends like you who pray, give, and stand with us. Thank you for having a part in what God is doing here in Thailand. May the Lord richly bless you!
